TERROIR

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| Vine age | About 20 years old. |
| Soil | Calcareous marls and river sediments. |
| Influence | High exposure to the sun. |
| Vineyard management | Organic and HVE (high environmental value). |

TECHNICAL DETAILS

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| Harvest | By night to preserve aromatic freshness. |
| Vinification process | Thermo-regulated vinification, stabulation on sludge for 10 days, then fermentation. Aged 1 month on fine lees to release thiols, then 3 months in stainless steel tanks. |
| Ageing | Stainless steel tank. |

TASTING NOTES

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| Eye | Pale color with green highlights. |
| Nose | Nose of exotic, sappy fruit and pomelos. |
| Mouth | Lively palate of lemons and pomelos. |
| Finish | Mineral, rich with lemony notes. |
